<u>Project Description:</u> The proposed development includes three buildings, Building A and B are 49,508 SF each and Building C is 129,520 SF, of industrial uses that will serve as office/warehouse and office/manufacturing uses for future tenants, on an 11.8 acre site with associated improvements including, drive aisle, parking, landscaping, and underground utility infrastructure.
