



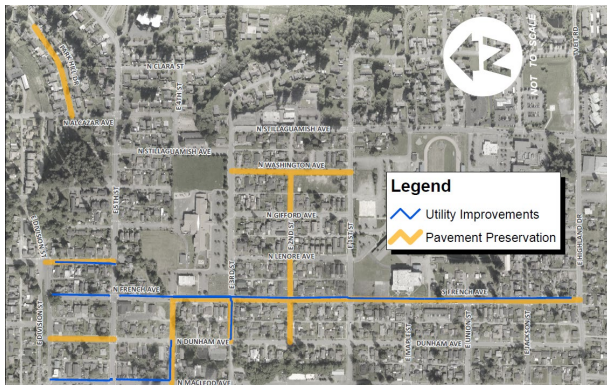
2021 Public Works Projects

Utility and Street Improvements

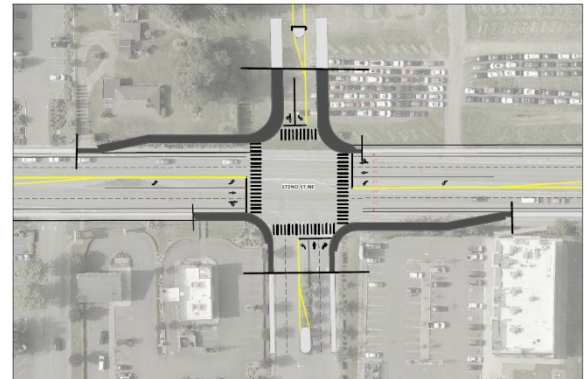
Message from the Mayor:

I am looking forward to spring and summer as we get ready for good NW weather. Our winter planning has identified the utility and street improvements we will undertake during the 2021 season. Below you can read a short description of each project, all designed to keep our systems in good working order and develop additional street projects to address our growth and congestion. Our projects communication staff will keep us all informed through the construction process.

- **Utility and Pavement Preservation (UPP):** The This year the north end of Arlington will see the installation of approximately one mile of new water main, replacing aged and failing water main, and the resurfacing of approximately 1.5 miles of roadway. Construction will occur over the summer and be complete in fall 2021.



- **SR 531 / 40th St NE Signal:** A new signal will be installed at the intersection of 40th Ave and 172nd St this year. Included with this project is a solid landscaped median on 172nd St from Smokey Point Blvd to 43rd Ave, pedestrian crosswalks, and two bus pull-outs for future transit use. Construction to begin summer/fall 2021.



- **Manhole Cover and Valve Adjustments:** Water valves, sewer, and stormwater manhole covers across Arlington will be adjusted to better match the grade of the surrounding roadway. Adjustment locations will be throughout Arlington, work is scheduled for summer 2021.
- **204th St NE / 74th Ave NE Signal:** The City will be installing a traffic signal at the intersection of 204th St NE and 74th Ave NE. Design is estimated to be complete in summer 2021.
- **New Water Source:** The City has been preparing on expanding its water supply. This work will continue through 2022.

- **Smokey Point Overlay:** Arlington will resurface the southern end of Smokey Point Blvd, from 174th Ave to 164th Ave. The project includes a 2-inch pavement overlay, restriping pavement, and replacement of non-compliant ADA ramps. Construction to begin summer 2021.





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- **173rd Ave Phase 1:** Phase 1 of a planned two lane road between Smokey Point Blvd and Airport Blvd will be constructed in 2021. This first phase will construct a new road, 173rd St, and multi-use trail from Smokey Point Blvd to 40th Ave. Construction is anticipated to begin spring/summer 2021.



- **SR-530/Smokey Point Blvd Roundabout:** The City is partnering with WSDOT, Snohomish County and the Stillaguamish Tribe to install a roundabout at SR 530 and Smokey Point Blvd. Design completion is anticipated for summer 2021 with construction start pending project funding.
