QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be at least 18 years of age and able to work legally in the United States;
- High school diploma or equivalent (GED);
- Washington State driving record acceptable to the City of Arlington;
- Current Washington State EMT certification;
- Current Washington State Firefighter 1 certification;
- Current CPAT, completed within the past year
- Successfully pass a medical examination by a doctor chosen by the City of Arlington;
- Successfully complete the EMT Integration Program and other departmental training requirements;
- Successfully pass a background check through the WSP WATCH program

APPLICATION PROCESS:

- Applicants must submit a completed [City of Arlington Application](#), and provide copies of their current EMT certification, FF1 certification, current CPAT, and current Washington State Department of Licensing Driver Abstract.
