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City of Arlington Seeking Volunteers for Citizen Salary Review Commission

(Arlington, WA) – The City of Arlington is looking for volunteers to fill vacancies on the Citizen Salary Review Commission. The City currently has three vacancies to fill on the Commission.

The Citizen Salary Review Commission was created in 2015 to get citizens' input on the salaries of their elected officials. The commission meets every two years to review the current salary and per diem reimbursement rates of the Mayor and City Councilmembers to ensure the salaries and rates are based on realistic standards according to their duties. The Commission consists of five members who are appointed by the Mayor, with City Council consent. Members must be at least 21 years old, registered to vote, and maintain a personal residence within the Arlington city limits. City of Arlington employees, officials, or immediate family members of any official or employee are ineligible.

Applications are accepted year round for all City boards and commissions. If you wish to serve on the Citizen Salary Commission you are requested to submit your application no later 5:00 p.m. on January 6, 2017, so the commission can complete their work before the June 30, 2017 deadline.
