## HOW TO ENTER

- All entries must be delivered to the show between noon and 6 p.m. Friday, Feb. 5 at Magnolia Hall, 225 E. Third Street, downtown Arlington. No submissions will be accepted after this time. (If delivery at this time is a problem, make arrangements with Roberta Baker at 360-474-8576.)
- \$5 per entry for up to four entries
  - one eagle photograph
  - up to four entries total
- Prints/artwork may not be smaller than 8 by 10 inches and not larger than 18 x 24 inches (including frame).
- **Photos can be framed or canvas wrapped. All 2-D art MUST have a wire for hanging.**
- All entries must be labeled on back with artist's name and phone number.
- Submit with completed entry form and a label for each work of art.

### YOUTH CATEGORY

- For youth under age 18, entry fee is a non-perishable food item for the food bank.
- Youth art will be eligible for prizes and the People's Choice Award.
- Youth art must meet art entry requirements.

## Festival events include:

- Nature walks, river float trips
- Live eagles and other birds from Sarvey Wildlife Rescue Center at City Hall
- Chainsaw carvers at Legion Park
- Antique tractors in the city parking lot
- Fish awareness activities at City Hall

## RULES & ENTRY INFORMATION

### ELIGIBILITY

The Eagle Photography Contest and Nature Art Show are both open to all ages and levels of experience of residents in Snohomish County and Camano Island.

### SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Entry fee is \$5 per piece of art.
- For youth, entry fee is a food bank donation.
- Only **one eagle photograph** may be entered.
- Maximum of four entries total.
- Eagle photographs must portray eagles in their natural environment.
- For the Nature Art Show, all entries must have a nature theme and must be original art created by the entrant. (Limited edition art prints, OK)
- Nature art entries can be photographs, paintings, multi-media, fabric, original prints, and three-dimensional sculptures, woodwork, clay, i.e. **ALL MEDIA WELCOME**

### JUDGING & PRIZES

- First, second and third place photos will be selected by a committee of community art advocates.
- First Place Eagle Photo will receive \$100.
- People's Choice winner receives \$100.
- First, second and third-place ribbons will be awarded in the youth category, up to age 18.

### WINNERS ANNOUNCED

- Judges choices will be marked with ribbons.
- People's Choice winner will be announced at 4:30 p.m.
- The grand prize photo in the Eagle Photography Contest will be displayed on the city's website, featured in the city's newsletter and used in other ways to promote the city and future Eagle Festivals.
- Textile artists who want to demonstrate their skills in Textile Artists in Action, should call Sharon Johnson at 425-238-1047.
- Haiku poetry can be entered at the websites listed on front.
