PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The City of Arlington Public Works Department is proposing roadway improvements along 211th Place NE between State Route 530 and 67th Avenue NE. The proposed improvements include roadway rehabilitation for freight and vehicle movement, improved drainage, utility improvements, a grade separated 12-foot-wide multi-use path for bicyclists and pedestrians, ADA compliant curb ramps, street amenities such as artwork and landscaping, and street lighting. The intersection at 67th Avenue NE will also be improved to allow for wider truck turning movements.

SEPA THRESHOLD DETERMINATION: The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030 (2) (c). This decision was made after reviewing a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the City of Arlington. This information is available to the public on request.
