PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The 2024 AMC Chapter 20.76 Zoning Code Amendment includes updates to the Screening and Trees code chapter. The city updated code language to ensure the retention, protection, and replacement of existing street trees, along with minor updates to the screening requirement table and grammatical corrections.
