**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The 2024 AMC Chapter 20.52 Zoning Code Amendment includes updates to the recreational facilities and open space chapter of the code. The city updated the residential mini-park requirements, purpose, and standards for both outdoor and indoor recreational facilities, residential community park impact fees, and residential usable open space. The amendment includes the addition of industrial recreational facility requirements, purpose, and standards for outdoor facilities and the addition of a future open space in-lieu mitigation fee. The city updated this chapter to ensure compliance with the new Parks and Recreation Master Plan.
