

Unanticipated Discovery Plan (UDP)

for

Construction of Level 3 EV_x charging
station with load managed battery
energy storage system at A1 Gas

Arlington, WA

1. Initial Discovery Response:

- Immediately stop all work within 30 feet of the discovery
- Secure and protect the area
- Notify the site supervisor/construction manager
- Cover/protect the discovery from weather elements if possible, without disturbing it

2. Required Notifications:

- Arlington City Planning Department
- Washington State Department of Archaeology & Historic Preservation (DAHP)
- Affected Tribal Groups (particularly Stillaguamish Tribe and Tulalip Tribes)
- Project Owner/Developer
- Archaeological consultant (if already contracted)

3. Documentation Requirements:

- Photograph the discovery and surrounding area
- Note the exact location using GPS coordinates
- Record depth of discovery
- Document soil conditions and stratigraphy
- Note any apparent associated features or artifacts
- Complete an initial discovery report

4. Wait Period and Assessment:

- Maintain work stoppage until authorized to proceed
- Allow for professional archaeological assessment
- Typically 24-48 hours for initial assessment

- May require longer if significant findings

5. Discovery Types Requiring Special Attention:

- In case of inadvertent discovery of human remains, you should:

1. Stop work immediately
2. Secure the area
3. Contact local law enforcement
4. Contact Dr. Tasa
5. Contact affected tribes

- Native American artifacts

- Historic structures or foundations

- Significant geological features
