

ARLINGTON MUNICIPAL AIRPORT UPDATE: TAXIWAY A IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT



PROJECT OVERVIEW

The AWO Taxiway A Improvements Project is expected to begin as early as April 14th and will be completed in three phases. As we approach the start date, we would like to inform tenants of upcoming impacts (including closures). We will continue to update and issue NOTAMs as we approach the project start date and Phase 1 completion.

We appreciate your understanding as we complete Taxiway A and Connector Twys A2 and A3 pavement rehabilitation, as well as reconstruction of Connector Twys A1 and A4 per FAA and WSDOT guidance.

The total project duration is 80 working days and work is divided into phases and subphases that will have varying impacts to airport operations. A working day is generally any day Monday-Friday, excluding holidays.

PROJECT IMPACTS - PHASE 1

Phase 1A | 34 Working Days

Impacted Area: **Taxiway A will be closed south of Twy A2**

- Twy A1 will be closed
- Twy A2 will remain open
- Aircraft located in the southeast hangars on the field can taxi to the east ramp for access to Taxiway A - refer to taxiway access map provided below


Phase 1B | 6 Working Days within Phase 1A

Impacted Area: **Rwy 16/34 and Rwy 11/29 FULL CLOSURES**

- Both runways will be closed for six days near the end of May for work within the Runway 16-34 Object Free Area and under the Runway 29 approach
- Exact dates for runway closures will be provided closer to the start of Phase 1B

There may be prior permission required (PPR) windows during the closures for aircraft movements on a scheduled, per-case basis. PPRs must be coordinated in advance with Airport Operations.

Phase 2 Scheduling and impact procedures will be announced near completion of Phase 1 construction. Project schedule and dates are subject to change and any changes will be communicated. Check your NOTAMs!
