PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The 2025 AMC Chapter 20.68 Zoning Code Amendment includes updates to section 20.68.020 clarifying the type of public information signs excluded from regulations, an increase to the square footage allowed, and when building permits would be required.

TO APPEAL A DECISION: An agency or person may appeal the City's procedural compliance with WAC Chapter 197-11-390(2)(a) for issuance of this DNS.
