Agency comments are to be submitted to the City Staff Contact via email or through the postal service. Regardless of the method, the City asks that SEPA comments be provided on their respective agency's formal letterhead.

Once received, comments will be made part of the official record on file with the City. After the

close of the comment period, the City will review all comments received, and may, at its discretion, modify, or add conditions to mitigate for newly identified environmental impacts. Please note that the City will only accept written SEPA comments. Following City review, all SEPA comments received within the comment period will be forwarded directly to the project applicant.

Comments received (or post-marked, if mailed) outside of the comment period will not be considered or made part of the record.

The due date for this review is 5:00 pm on April 10, 2025.

The Community Neighborhood meeting will be held on April 7, 2025 from 5:00 – 6:00 pm, with a presentation at 5:15 pm
