



CONVOY OF HOPE DISASTER RELIEF: ARLINGTON, WA.

Description: During this time of difficulty and uncertainty, we are excited and thankful to be able to provide this much needed food and supplies to those who need it the most in our communities. The Convoy of Hope semi-truck will be bringing resources (food and supplies) to be distributed to the north Snohomish County area in Arlington, WA, at LIFEchurch360. The truck is scheduled to arrive either Wednesday (4.29) or Thursday (4.30).

Community Partners:

The Arlington Resource Center, Darrington Resource Center, Arlington Food Bank, Food Blessing Food for All, North Snohomish County Outreach.

Process: the truck will be unloaded, inventory taken, food bagged for distribution, and food distributed, with prayers for families in vehicles as they move in the drive-thru line.

Distribution:

- To spread out volunteers and keeping everyone safe - we have decided to schedule distribution in two different days:
 - Monday (5.4) and Tuesday (5.5) from 1-5 pm at LIFEchurch360 (3131 Smokey Point Dr. Suite 1B Arlington, WA 98223)
- **Vehicles:** To ensure a smooth and timely distribution of food bags and supplies to each vehicle, assigned volunteers will be watching and directing traffic flow and queueing in the parking lot area of the church.
 - If need be, to avoid any impact to moving traffic, overflow of vehicles will be held in the LIFEChurch360 Community building parking lot immediately across to the SE of the main distribution area.

- The distribution will function as a drive-thru style (same as ones being used by other food banks in the area) where volunteers place bags in the trunk of vehicles thereby having no physical contact and keeping the required social distancing.
- **Walk-up guests:** 6-foot (tape) intervals will be placed on standing surfaces to ensure social distancing while in the line. Food bags will be distributed to this group as first come first served.
- **Volunteers:** Are required to follow all social distancing guidelines, wear masks, and gloves. Everyone who has a mask will bring their own, if not one will be provided.
 - Area will also be marked with tape to enforce social distancing boundaries between volunteers.
