Project Description

The City of Arlington will be installing a traffic signal at the intersection of 40th Ave and 172nd St with a solid median from 43rd Ave to Smokey Point Blvd. U-turns will be allowed at the signal to ensure vehicles have continued access to businesses along the corridor. When complete, this project will improve traffic safety through Smokey Point while also making it a safe route for pedestrians and bicyclists.

Benefits of the Project

- Improve traffic safety and mobility
- Increase pedestrian safety by adding a pedestrian crosswalk.
- Add safe bus turnouts

Project Funding

- Engineer's Estimate: \$1,400,000
- Washington State Transportation Improvement Board Grant: \$1,120,000
- City of Arlington Funds: \$280,000

Project Schedule

- Design Completion: Spring 2021
- Project Bid: Spring 2021
- Construction Start: Summer/Fall 2021
