Fatality Motor Vehicle Collision Involving Two Pedestrians

UPDATE #1

(Arlington, WA) - On 01/20/2022, the Arlington Police Department, with assistance from the Snohomish County Sheriff's Office and Washington State Patrol, is investigating a fatal collision at the intersection of 204th Street NE and State Route 9 in Arlington.

At approximately 2:38 a.m., Arlington Police and North County Fire and EMS responded to the location for the report of a collision involving two adult pedestrians. Both pedestrians suffered life-threatening injuries and were pronounced deceased at the scene.

Positive identification of the decedents, as well as cause and manner of death, will be determined by the Snohomish County Medical Examiner.

Arlington Police have booked the driver of the involved vehicle, a 28-year-old Stanwood man, into the Snohomish County Jail for investigation of two (2) counts of Vehicular Homicide (RCW 46.61.520) and investigation of one (1) count Driving Under the Influence (RCW 46.61.502).

Vehicular Homicide is a Class A felony punishable by confinement in a state correctional institution for a term of up to life imprisonment, or by a fine in an amount fixed by the court of fifty thousand dollars, or by both such confinement and fine.

State Route 9 will be closed for some period to investigate. Therefore, the public is encouraged to avoid the area and seek alternate routes.
